OHIO YAB Youth Stipend Program

Program Purpose

The purpose of the OHIO YAB Youth Stipend Program is to cultivate skills and provide leadership opportunities for Ohio foster care youth.

Program Stipulations

- OHIO YAB stipends are awarded to OHIO YAB members, who participate in approved events such as:
 - Participating in panels
 - Facilitating youth leadership trainings
 - Presenting workshops
- OHIO YAB Quarterly Meetings are <u>not</u> part of the OHIO YAB Youth Stipend Program.

Youth Eligibility

- Age: Youth must be fourteen or older, and either currently be under the custody of a Public Child Serving Agency or have been under the custody of children services in the past.
- **OHIO YAB membership:** Youth must formally be signed up as an OHIO YAB member (see *Youth Membership Sign Up Form*).
- OHIO YAB Code of Conduct: Only youth who have signed the Ohio YAB
 Code of Conduct will be considered to represent "the statewide voice of
 foster care youth" during events.

Program Description

Youth will be reimbursed:

- \$50 dollars for a half-day event (less than 4 hours, including travel time)
- \$100 for a full day event (more than 4 hours, including travel time)
- \$100 for a video (because they are giving away the rights to share that video in various forums)

Notification

Youth are recommended to regularly attend OHIO YAB Quarterly
 Meetings to receive prompt information regarding stipend opportunities,
 and to maintain an active email account in order to be connected with
 events and opportunities sent out via emails.
