


# Musiah Wadud, age 4

- At the time of his death, Musiah had over 100 marks on his body; including skull fractures, ligature marks in various stages of healing, numerous bruises and lacerations.
- **He and his brother** had been placed in the custody of their aunt and her boyfriend.
- Three other young children were removed from the aunt's home by Cuyahoga County's Department of Child and Family Services. One child required medical attention.

# **Curtis Witcher, age 3**

# • Curtis's mother gave birth to six children, and they were all removed from her care. But Curtis was returned to the custody of his mother when he was two and a half years old.

- His body was found in a stroller in Family Dollar in Cleveland.
- His loss of life was due to blunt force trauma at the hands of his mother.

# Darnell Taylor, age 5

- **Darnell's loss of life** was due to suffocation, after which his body was placed in a sewer.
- **Darnell's grandmother** repeatedly contacted Franklin County Children Services to report concerns about his safety.
- Both Darnell's maternal and paternal grandparents had gone to court to get visitation for their grandson, saying Maye had blocked their calls and they weren't able to get ahold of the couple to have regular visitation

# Martonio Wilder, age 8

- **Prior to Martonio's loss of life,** the police were called to his residence 13 times over an 18-month period. This includes 3 times for domestic violence, twice for a domestic disturbance, and once for a stabbing.
- Franklin County Children Services chose to use an alternative response rather than a traditional one. A traditional response could have saved Martonio's life.
- The coroner reported that Martonio was severely malnourished. His autopsy photos revealed visible bruises around his eyes, nose and mouth, as well as laceratons and cuts on his face and back.

# June 28, 2024



## Emmanuel Mims, age 3

- **Emmanuel Mims** died from burns he suffered after allegedly spilling boiling water.
- Franklin County Children's Services said it had been working with the family prior to the child's death, and that two other children living in that apartment had since been placed in their care.
- Police records obtained in January showed that officers had gone to the home in South Franklinton on calls for domestic disputes, domestic violence, person with a knife, person with a gun and a missing person report.



#### Kei'Mani Latigue, age 13

#### March 24, 2025

- **Kei'Mani's father** raped her, cut off her hands and cut her throat.
- **Kei'Mani's teachers** had called Lucas County Children Services to report previous concerns, including visible bruising and things Kei'Mani had self-reported to teachers, peers and the bus driver.
- Lucas County Children Services said the agency investigated multiple reports regarding the care of Kei'Mani Latigue, but never found any evidence that would lead to removing the girl from her former placement.



## Ja'Kai Smith, age 4

- Ja'Kai suffered abuse and neglect before his death, which resulted from multiple brain bleeds and hypothermia.
- Less than a month before his death, Franklin County Children Services received a neglect report involving Ja'Kai.
- Two years earlier, on December 2023, Franklin County Children Services received a report of endangerment concerns but caseworkers closed the case without taking action, Varner said in the statement.
- At the time of his death, Ja'Kai was so malnourished that he weighed only 35 pounds.

# April 10, 2025



# Eva Bretz, age 6

- At the time of her death, Eva had visible injuries, including bruising and ligature marks around her neck, as well as a severed liver and trauma to other portions of her body.
- According to the autopsy report, her injuries demonstrated a pattern of violence occurring for at least weeks, and probably months prior to the child's death.
- Franklin County Children Services confirmed that Eva's three siblings were taken from Fagan's care. Two older siblings are in the agency's custody, and a younger sibling was placed with their biological father.

April 13, 2025
